An editor has a default border and focus border. It looks like following:



But sometimes you want a specific color for the border:



It's simple to set your custom border color, e.g.

```
editor.setStyle(new Style("f_border_color_#aa0000"));
```

The format is: f_border[_focused]_color{[_#ColorInHex]}[_#ColorForDarkMode]

{ } ⇒ required

[] ⇒ optional, can be cut out

If you use an editor for an image cell editor, the editor doesn't show a border. To show the border in this case, add 'f_standard_border' as style name.
