A simple screen is shown with a safe-area around it, to be able to click/tap all components. Many devices have a rounded case and the UI should work without problems, e.g.



The first screenshot doesn't use a safe-area and the table overlaps the case. The second screenshot uses a safe-area and everything fits. But if you need the full-size. It's possible to disable the safe-area with following style:

`f_full_size`

We have more style options:

- `f_background_in_title`
- `f_simple_menu`
- `f_no_menu`
- `f_no_back`
- `f_overview_back`
- `f_secure`

The `f_background_in_title` will use the background color of the screen for the title as well. This will override the general [screen title color](#). The `f_simple_menu` will show a minimalistic menu instead of the full drawer menu.



Above screenshot shows both styles in action.

The `f_no_menu` hides the men, `f_no_back` removes the back arrow, `f_overview_back` navigates to the application overview instead the menu.
